Background

Formation of the Newhall Ranch Sanitation District of Los Angeles County (NRSD) is needed to provide sewerage service to the Newhall Ranch Specific Plan area. On May 27, 2003, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors certified the Final Environmental Impact Report and Final Additional Analysis for the Newhall Ranch Specific Plan and Water Reclamation Plant project (Newhall Ranch EIR) and adopted the Specific Plan and other project approvals, including Conditional Use Permit No. 94-087-(5), which authorized construction of the Newhall Ranch Water Reclamation Plant (WRP).

The approved Specific Plan, including the WRP site, encompasses approximately 11,963 acres and is generally located in the northern portion of unincorporated Los Angeles County in the Santa Clarita Valley planning area. The adopted Specific Plan allows up to 21,308 dwelling units, 629 acres of mixed-use development, 67 acres of commercial uses, 249 acres of business park land uses, 37 acres of visitor-serving uses, over 6,100 acres of open space and special management areas, various public service facilities and infrastructure, associated community facilities, and construction of the WRP. The Specific Plan build-out would eventually result in an on-site resident population of approximately 60,000 persons. The Specific Plan site is presently undeveloped, vacant property with no current population or registered voters.

The approved WRP site is to be situated in one of the Specific Plan Business Park areas, located on the south side of State Route 126 (SR-126), north of and adjacent to the Santa Clara River, and near the Los Angeles County/Ventura County boundary line on the western edge of the Specific Plan site. The WRP will provide wastewater treatment, disposal and recycled water within the Specific Plan site. The WRP will be built in stages, as the Specific Plan area is developed, and will ultimately be sized to treat up to 6.8 million gallons per day (mgd) of wastewater at build-out of the Specific Plan.

The WRP will consist of primary, secondary and tertiary treatment facilities, as well as solids handling and disinfection facilities. The WRP will reclaim the maximum amount of wastewater generated by the Specific Plan development in order to meet a portion of the non-potable water demand of the Specific Plan area. As such, the WRP would be a zero, or near zero, discharge system. Such a system is intended to reclaim all treated wastewater for reuse within the Specific Plan area for irrigation purposes, except for

potentially wet winters when irrigation demands would be lower and some discharge of unused reclaimed water to the Santa Clara River would occur. The WRP is the only aspect of the Newhall Ranch project that was reviewed at a project construction level of detail in the Newhall Ranch EIR and approved under Conditional Use Permit No. 94-087-(5).

As part of the certified Newhall Ranch EIR, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors adopted a mitigation measure (Mitigation Measure 5.0-52) that contemplated formation of a new county sanitation district to provide service to the approved Specific Plan site. Mitigation Measure 5.0-52 specifically stated that a "new County sanitation district shall be formed to administer operation of the Newhall Ranch water reclamation plant." This measure also stated that the new county sanitation district would "encompass the entire Newhall Ranch Specific Plan site." This mitigation measure was adopted by the Board of Supervisors when it certified the Newhall Ranch EIR on May 27, 2003.

<u>Location</u>: Newhall Ranch is located in the northern portion of unincorporated Los Angeles County in the Santa Clarita Valley planning area. The area is irregular in shape (approximately 5 miles east-west and approximately 5.5 miles north-south) and encompasses 11,963 acres. Both SR-126 and the Santa Clara River transect the site from east to west. The Golden State Freeway (I-5) corridor is the major freeway near Newhall Ranch, located approximately one mile east of the Specific Plan site. Further to the east of I-5 are the City of Santa Clarita and the planned community of Valencia.

Purpose of Request: By application, the County of Los Angeles, Department of Public Works (DPW), has requested formation of the NRSD to implement the mitigation measure calling for a new county sanitation district encompassing the Specific Plan area. On December 13, 2005, pursuant to the provisions of the County Sanitation District Act (Health and Safety Code 4700 et seq.), the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors adopted a resolution of intent to form the NRSD and directed DPW to file with LAFCO the necessary application to initiate formation of the new sanitation district, along with certified copies of its resolution, the required plan for providing services within the Newhall Ranch Specific Plan area, and other documents as may be required to assist LAFCO in processing the application.

<u>Protest Requirements</u>: Pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 4714.5, the Commission must terminate proceedings if written protests have been filed by landowners owning more than one-half of the total assessment value of the real property within the proposed district. If a majority protest of the landowners does not exist, the Commission shall order the District formed.

Correspondence

Newhall Land, as the sole owner of land within the territory, has filed a letter supporting approval of the formation proceedings.

Recommendation:

- 1) Open the public hearing and receive any testimony and/or written protests regarding Formation of Newhall Ranch County Sanitation District.
- 2) There being no further testimony or written protests, close the public hearing.
- 3) Instruct the Executive Officer to determine the value of those protests filed and not withdrawn and report back to the Commission with the results.
- 4) Based upon the results of the protest hearing, adopt a resolution either terminating the formation proceedings pursuant to Health and Safety Code 4714.5, or ordering the District formed.

WHEREAS, the County of Los Angeles adopted a resolution of application to initiate proceedings before the Local Agency Formation Commission for Los Angeles County (the "Commission") pursuant to Part 3, Division 3, Title 5 of the California Government Code (commencing with section 56000, the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000), for formation of a new County Sanitation District in the northern portion of unincorporated Los Angeles County; and

WHEREAS, the principal reason for this formation of district is to provide wastewater treatment, disposal and recycled water sewerage service to the Newhall Ranch Specific Plan area; and

WHEREAS, a description of the boundaries and map of the proposal are set forth in Exhibits "A" and "B," attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, the subject territory is uninhabited and consists of approximately 11,963 acres; and

WHEREAS, the short-form designation given this proposal is "Formation of Newhall Ranch County Sanitation District;" and

WHEREAS, on June 14, 2006, the Commission approved Formation of Newhall Ranch County Sanitation District; and WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 57002, the Executive Officer of the Commission has set July 26, 2006 as the date for the protest hearing and has given notice thereof; and

WHEREAS, at the time and place fixed in the notice, the hearing was held, and any and all oral or written protests, objections and evidence were received and considered; and

WHEREAS, the Commission, acting as the conducting authority, has the ministerial duty of tabulating the value of protests filed and not withdrawn and either terminating these proceedings if a majority protest exists or ordering the formation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

- The Commission finds that the number of landowners within the boundary of the territory is <u>1.</u>
- 2. The Commission finds that the number of written protests filed in opposition to Formation of Newhall Ranch County Sanitation District and not withdrawn is ___ landowners owning __ assessed value of land which, even if valid, represents less than one-half of the total assessed value of land within the affected territory.

- a. The Commission hereby orders the formation of the territory described in Exhibit "A" hereto, which description is incorporated herein by reference.
- 4. Pursuant to Government Code section 56886, the formation is made subject to the following terms and conditions:
 - a. The District will be formed pursuant to California Health and Safety
 Code Section 4700, et seq., and the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local
 Government Act of 2000;
 - b. The Board of Supervisors will be the governing body of the District;
 - c. The Board of Supervisors, as governing body of the District, will be authorize to prescribe such service charges, fees, assessments, and/or taxes upon the property within the District as the District may legally impose;
 - d. Any fees, charges, assessments, or taxes for the District may be collected by the County of Los Angeles Treasurer and Tax Collector in the same manner as ad valorem property taxes to the extent authorized by law;

- e. The District will be required to make formal application to the existing
 24 county sanitation districts to become signatory to the Amended
 Joint Administration Agreement, dated July 1, 1980, of the County
 Sanitation Districts of Los Angeles County;
- f. The District will be required to make formal application to the SCVSD to enter into an agreement with Santa Clarita Valley Sanitation District regarding the ownership and operation of the Water Reclamation Plant for Newhall Ranch, as required by Contract No. 3868, dated January 9, 2003, between Santa Clarita Valley Sanitation District and the Newhall Land and Farming Company; and
- g. The regular County assessment roll will be utilized by the District.
- h. The District's Sphere of Influence is coterminous with the boundary set forth in Exhibits "A" and "B":
- 5. The Executive Officer is directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the County of Los Angeles, upon the County's payment of the applicable fees required by Government Code Section 54902.5, and prepare, execute and file a certificate of completion with the appropriate public agencies, pursuant to Government Code Section 57000, *et seq.*

GOVERNMENT CODE § 56857 NOTICES

(For Informational Purposes Only, Receive and File)

Upon receipt of any proposed change of organization or reorganization that includes the annexation of territory to any district, if the proposal is not filed by the district to which annexation of territory is proposed, Government Code section 56857 requires LAFCO to place the proposal on its agenda for informational purposes only. Within 60 days of the meeting date, the annexing district may adopt and submit to LAFCO a resolution requesting termination of the annexation proceedings. The law requires that the annexing district "present written findings supported by substantial evidence in the record that the termination request is justified by a financial or service related concern." Prior to the Commission's determination of termination of proceedings the resolution is subject to judicial review.

Waiver of 60-Day Termination Period

Under section 56857, LAFCO may not hear and consider the proposed annexation until the 60-day termination period has expired. The Code provides, however, that the Commission may waive the 60-day termination period if the annexing district adopts and submits to LAFCO a resolution supporting the change of organization or reorganization.

The following is a summary of the annexation proposals filed with LAFCO:

a. Project Description – Annexation No. 2006-18

Buzz Oates Enterprises to annex 40 acres of vacant land into the boundary of Los Angeles County Waterworks District No. 40.

Project Location

The project site is generally located at the northeast corner of the intersection of Avenue G and 30th Street West all within the City of Lancaster.

b. *Project Description – Annexation 2006-23*Hatzlacha filed an application to annex 17.5 acres of vacant land into the boundary of Los Angeles County Waterworks District No. 40.

Project Location

The project site is generally located on the northeast corner of Avenue J and 42nd Street West all within the City of Lancaster.

Item No. 5a is a report to the Commission, pursuant to Government Code Section 57075.5, to determine the value of those protests filed and not withdrawn and report back to the Commission with the results on the value of protests received regarding Santa Clarita Annexation No. 2002-09A.

<u>Annexation Proposal</u>: The proposal requests annexation of approximately 409.4 acres of inhabited county territory to the City of Santa Clarita. The applicant of record is the City of Santa Clarita, the proposal having been initiated by City of Santa Clarita Resolution No. 02-115. The application was received on July 26, 2002.

Background:

LAFCO held an initial public hearing regarding City of Santa Clarita Annexation No. 2002-09A on January 11, 2006. The Commission approved the annexation and adopted the Resolution Making Determinations and Approving City of Santa Clarita Annexation No. 2002-09A.

On June 28, 2006, LAFCO held a protest hearing regarding City of Santa Clarita Annexation No. 2002-09A. Pursuant to Government Code Section 57026, written protests could be filed beginning March 30, 2006, to the conclusion of the protest hearing on June 28th. Only written protests signed and dated on or after March 30, 2006, and received before the conclusion of the protest hearing, were counted toward the protest.

Conclusion:

Pursuant to Government Code Section 57075.5, the Commission may: (a) terminate proceedings if written protests have been filed and not withdrawn by 50 percent or more of the registered voters within the affected territory; (b) order the territory annexed subject to confirmation by special election within the affected territory if written protests have been filed and not withdrawn by either 15 percent or more of the registered voters or 15 percent or more of the number of landowners owning not less than 15 percent of the total assessed value of land; or (c) order the territory annexed if written protests have been filed and not withdrawn by less than 15 percent of the registered voters and less than 15 percent of the landowners who own less than 15 percent of the total assessed value of land.

There were a total of 1147 registered voters within the affected territory, as of June 28, 2006, as determined by the County of Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk. Staff has received a total of 253 unverified written protests and 171 unverified withdrawals of protest.

The following is a detailed tabulation of written protests and withdrawals received, as verified by the Los Angeles County Registrar Recorder/County Clerk, and a tabulation of the assessed value of land for each written protest submitted by a landowner and not withdrawn before the close of the protest hearing.

Recommendation:

The percentage of written protests filed and not withdrawn, of both registered voters and landowners, fall short of the 15% minimum required by Government Code 57075.5 for the Commission to call for an election.
