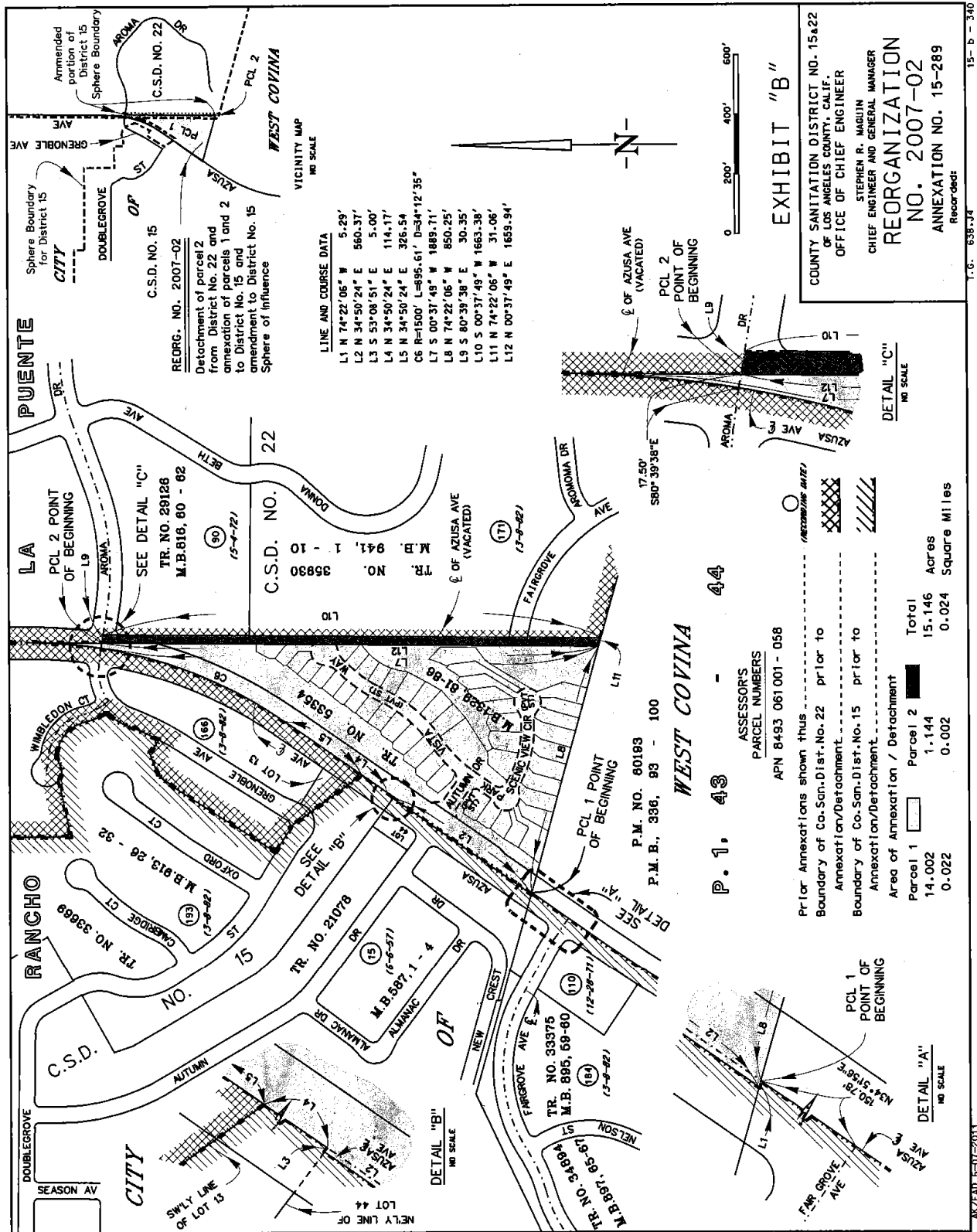

NOTICE OF INTENT TO WAIVE PROTEST PROCEEDINGS**

**REORGANIZATION NO. 2007-02 (15-289) TO LOS ANGELES COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT NO. 15. AMEND THE SPHERE OF INFLUENCE FOR LOS ANGELES COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT NO. 15 AND LOS ANGELES COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT NO. 22; DETACH FROM COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT NO. 22; AND ANNEX TO COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT NO. 15.**

Pursuant to Government Code Section 56663, the Local Agency Formation Commission for the County of Los Angeles ("LAFCO" or "Commission") hereby gives notice as follows:

1. LAFCO will hold a public hearing/proceedings on Wednesday, September 11, 2013 at 9:00 a.m., to hear and receive any oral or written objections, or evidence that is made, presented, or filed regarding the proposed sphere of influence amendments of Los Angeles County Sanitation District No. 15, and Los Angeles County Sanitation District No. 22, detachment of said territory from Los Angeles County Sanitation District No. 22; and annexation of inhabited territory to the Los Angeles County Sanitation District No. 15. ("Proposal"). The hearing will be held in the Board of Supervisors Hearing Room, Room 381B, Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, 500 West Temple Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012, or to such date and time as it may be continued by LAFCO.
2. Proceedings for this reorganization were initiated by resolution of application by the Los Angeles County Sanitation District.
3. The Proposal has been assigned the following short form designation:  
"Reorganization No. 2007-02 (15-289) to Los Angeles County Sanitation District No. 15".
4. The Proposal includes a reorganization of 15.146± acres of residential land into the boundary of the Los Angeles County Sanitation District No. 15; detachment from Los Angeles County Sanitation District No. 22, annexation to Los Angeles County Sanitation District No. 15, and Sphere of Influence amendments.
5. The affected territory is generally located at Azusa Avenue between Fairgrove Avenue and Aroma Drive, located within the City of West Covina. See map on reverse for a complete description of the exterior boundaries of the proposed change of organization.
6. The reason for the reorganization as set forth in the proposal to LAFCO is to obtain off-site sewage service for the collection and disposal of wastewater and allow the landowners to connect to an existing trunk sewer line.
7. Please be advised that, in the event this proposal for reorganization is approved by the Commission, the land within the affected territory is potentially subject to the extension or continuation of any previously authorized charge, fee, assessment, or tax by the District.

Said hearing/proceedings on the proposal for reorganization will be held at 9:00 a.m., on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of September 2013, in Room 381B of the Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, 500 West Temple Street, Los Angeles, California, 90012, or as it may be continued.
