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#### **NOTICE OF PROTEST HEARING/PROCEEDINGS**

# REORGANIZATION NO. 2016-08 TO THE CITY OF BRADBURY (DETACHMENT FROM THE CITY OF MONROVIA AND ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF BRADBURY)


Pursuant to Government Code Section 57000 *et seq.,* the Local Agency Formation Commission for the County of Los Angeles ("LAFCO" or "Commission") hereby gives notice as follows:

- LAFCO will hold a protest hearing/proceedings on Wednesday, January 10, 2018 at 9:00 a.m., to hear
  and receive any oral or written protest, objections, or evidence that is made, presented, or filed
  regarding the proposed reorganization of uninhabited territory to the City of Bradbury ("Proposal"). The
  hearing will be held in the Board of Supervisors Hearing Room, Room 381B, Kenneth Hahn Hall of
  Administration, 500 West Temple Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012, or to such date and time as it may be
  continued by LAFCO.
- 2. Proceedings for this reorganization were initiated by resolution of application by the City of Bradbury.
- The Proposal has been assigned the following short form designation: "Reorganization No. 2016-08 to the City of Bradbury".
- 4. The Proposal includes annexation of 2.96 ± acres within a residential area into the boundary of the City of Bradbury and Consolidated Fire Protection District; and detachment from the City of Monrovia.
- 5. The affected territory is located east of the intersection of Wild Rose Avenue and Deodar Lane, in the City of Monrovia. A complete description of the exterior boundaries of the proposed change of organization; as well and the terms and conditions is set forth in the Local Agency Formation Commission for the County of Los Angeles Resolution No. 2017-38RMD Making Determinations. The resolution is available at the LAFCO offices at 80 South Lake Avenue, Suite 870, Pasadena, CA 91101 (626) 204-6500. See map on reverse for a complete description of the exterior boundaries of the proposed change of organization.
- 6. The reason for the reorganization as set forth in the proposal to LAFCO is to place property that is within Bradbury Estates Association into the City of Bradbury.
- 7. Please be advised that, in the event this proposal for reorganization is approved by the Commission, the land within the affected territory is potentially subject to the extension or continuation of any previously authorized charge, fee, assessment, or tax by the City and/or District. In the event that any written opposition or comments are mailed or hand-delivered to LAFCO, rather than being hand-delivered to the hearing location listed herein before the conclusion of the Commission hearing/proceedings on this proposal, such mailed or hand-delivered written opposition or comments must be received by the LAFCO Office, at the different address given below, no later than 5:00 p.m. on the business day preceding the date set for hearing/proceedings in order for the mailed or hand-delivered opposition or comments to be deemed timely and to be considered by the Commission in connection with the noticed hearing/proceedings.
- 8. Written protest <u>against</u> Reorganization No. 2016-08 to the City of Bradbury may be filed at any time <u>prior to the conclusion of the Protest Hearing/Proceedings</u>. Only written protests received prior to the conclusion of the Protest Hearing will be counted toward the protest. Any person who has filed a protest may withdraw that protest at any time prior to the conclusion of the hearing.
- 9. Protest forms are available at the LAFCO offices at 80 S. Lake Avenue, Suite 870, Pasadena, CA 91101 (626) 204-6500, and at LAFCO's website, <a href="http://lalafco.org">http://lalafco.org</a>. A protest may be submitted without using a form if the required information is included as described here. Written protest may only be submitted by a registered voter and/or owner of land within the proposed territory. The written protest must include the following information: (1) a statement that the protest is made by a registered voter and/or owner of land (2) concise statement that you are <a href="https://example.com/opposed">opposed</a> to the reorganization (3) printed name, signature, address (street, city, state and zip code), mailing address, if different, and date. All signatures without a date or bearing a date prior to the date of publication of notice shall be disregarded for the purposes of ascertaining the value of written protests. Written protest may be mailed or hand-delivered in advance of the hearing to LAFCO at 80 S. Lake Avenue, Suite 870, Pasadena, CA 91101 (626) 204-6500. Mailed or hand-delivered protests must be received by 5:00 p.m. on the business day preceding the hearing date to be counted for purposes of valuing protests, or protests may be submitted at the hearing prior to the conclusion of the hearing.

The subject proposal and all related documents are on file in the office of the Local Agency Formation Commission, 80 South Lake Avenue, Suite 870, Pasadena, California 91101, and may be examined by any person upon request. LAFCO meeting agendas are posted on-line prior to the meetings at www.lalafco.org. For further information, contact the LAFCO office at (626) 204-6500. The office hours are Monday – Thursday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., closed Fridays and Holidays.

### BY ORDER OF THE LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION.

Depending on the application involved, State Law requires that LAFCO notify various parties, such as landowners and registered voters, both within and adjacent to the affected territory. For this reason, you may receive multiple copies of this notice.





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
