NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING/PROCEEDINGS

ANNEXATION NO. 2014-04 TO THE CITY OF CALABASAS (AGOURA ROAD) AND AMENDMENT TO THE CITY OF CALABASAS SPHERE OF INFLUENCE (SOI)

Pursuant to Government Code Section 56650 *et seq.*, the Local Agency Formation Commission for the County of Los Angeles ("LAFCO" or "Commission") hereby gives notice as follows:

- 1. LAFCO will hold a public hearing/proceedings on Wednesday, January 9, 2019 at 9:00 a.m., to hear and receive any oral or written objections, or evidence that is made, presented, or filed regarding the proposed annexation of uninhabited territory to the City of Calabasas ("Proposal"). The hearing will be held in the Board of Supervisors Hearing Room, Room 381B, Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, 500 West Temple Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012, or to such date and time as it may be continued by LAFCO.
- 2. Proceedings for this annexation were initiated by resolution of application by the City of Calabasas.
- The Proposal has been assigned the following short form designation:
 "Annexation No. 2014-04 to the City of Calabasas (Agoura Road)".
- 4. The Proposal includes annexation of 57.78± acres within a commercial and open space area into the boundary of the City; amendment to the City of Calabasas SOI; withdrawal from County Lighting Maintenance District 1687 and the County Public library System; transfer of Jurisdiction over and accepting the negotiated exchange of benefit assessment process for the County Lighting and Landscaping Act District #2-32 from the County to the City; detachment from the County Road District NO. 3; and approving an agreement for sharing City sale tax revenues.
- 5. The affected territory is generally located east of the intersection of Liberty Canyon Road and Agoura Road, in Los Angeles County unincorporated territory adjacent to the City of Calabasas. See map on reverse for a complete description of the exterior boundaries of the proposed change of organization.
- 6. The reason for the annexation as set forth in the proposal to LAFCO is the quality of services provided by the City and the desire for local government representation.
- 7. Please be advised that, in the event this proposal for annexation is approved by the Commission, the land within the affected territory is potentially subject to the extension or continuation of any previously authorized charge, fee, assessment, or tax by the City.
 - Said hearing/proceedings on the proposal for annexation will be held at 9:00 a.m., on the 9th day of January 2019, in Room 381B of the Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, 500 West Temple Street, Los Angeles, California, 90012, or as it may be continued. At said hearing/proceedings, any interested person may present testimony or submit written opposition or comments prior to the conclusion of the Commission hearing/proceedings on the proposal. In the event that any written opposition or comments are mailed or hand-delivered to LAFCO, rather than being hand-delivered to the hearing location listed herein before the conclusion of the Commission hearing/proceedings on this proposal, such mailed or hand-delivered written opposition or comments must be received by the LAFCO Office, at the different address given below, no later than 5:00 p.m. on the business day preceding the date set for hearing/proceedings in order for the mailed or hand-delivered opposition or comments to be deemed timely and to be considered by the Commission in connection with the noticed hearing/proceedings.
- 9. The subject proposal and all related documents are on file in the office of the Local Agency Formation Commission, 80 South Lake Avenue, Suite 870, Pasadena, California 91101, and may be examined by any person upon request. 


Pursuant to Government Code Section 57000 *et seq.,* the Local Agency Formation Commission for the County of Los Angeles ("LAFCO" or "Commission") hereby gives notice as follows:

- LAFCO will hold a protest hearing/proceedings on Wednesday, January 09, 2019 at 9:00 a.m., to hear
 and receive any oral or written protest, objections, or evidence that is made, presented, or filed
 regarding the proposed <u>annexation of uninhabited territory to the City of Pomona ("Proposal").</u> The
 hearing will be held in the Board of Supervisors Hearing Room, Room 381B, Kenneth Hahn Hall of
 Administration, 500 West Temple Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012, or to such date and time as it may be
 continued by LAFCO.
- 2. Proceedings for this annexation were initiated by resolution of application by the City of Pomona.
- The Proposal has been assigned the following short form designation:"Annexation No. 2015-09 to the City of Pomona".
- 4. The Proposal includes annexation of 9.06± acres within an Industrial area into the boundary of the City of Pomona; detachment from Road District No. 1 and withdraw from County Public Library System.
- 5. The affected territory is generally located south of Valley Blvd approximately 2,500 feet northeast of the intersection of Grand Avenue and Valley Blvd. A complete description of the exterior boundaries of the proposed change of organization; as well and the terms and conditions is set forth in the Local Agency Formation Commission for the County of Los Angeles Resolution No. 2018-04RMD Making Determinations. The resolution is available at the LAFCO offices at 80 South Lake Avenue, Suite 870, Pasadena, CA 91101 (626) 204-6500. See map on reverse for a complete description of the exterior boundaries of the proposed change of organization.
- 6. The reason for the annexation as set forth in the proposal to LAFCO is place a proposed development under one jurisdiction and to create a logical boundary for the City consistent with applicable legal authorities and Board Policy 3.095 City Annexations and Spheres of Influence.
- 7. Please be advised that, in the event this proposal for annexation is approved by the Commission, the land within the affected territory is potentially subject to the extension or continuation of any previously authorized charge, fee, assessment, or tax by the City. In the event that any written opposition or comments are mailed or hand-delivered to LAFCO, rather than being hand-delivered to the hearing location listed herein before the conclusion of the Commission hearing/proceedings on this proposal, such mailed or hand-delivered written opposition or comments must be received by the LAFCO Office, at the different address given below, no later than 5:00 p.m. on the business day preceding the date set for hearing/proceedings in order for the mailed or hand-delivered opposition or comments to be deemed timely and to be considered by the Commission in connection with the noticed hearing/proceedings.
- 8. Written protest <u>against</u> Annexation No. 2015-09 to the City of Pomona may be filed at any time <u>prior to the conclusion of the Protest Hearing/Proceedings</u>. Only written protests received prior to the conclusion of the Protest Hearing will be counted toward the protest. Any person who has filed a protest may withdraw that protest at any time prior to the conclusion of the hearing.
- 9. Protest forms are available at the LAFCO offices at 80 S. Lake Avenue, Suite 870, Pasadena, CA 91101 (626) 204-6500, and at LAFCO's website, http://lalafco.org. A protest may be submitted without using a form if the required information is included as described here. Written protest may only be submitted by a registered voter and/or owner of land within the proposed territory. The written protest must include the following information: (1) a statement that the protest is made by a registered voter and/or owner of land (2) concise statement that you are opposed to the annexation (3) printed name, signature, address (street, city, state and zip code), mailing address, if different, and date. All signatures without a date or bearing a date prior to the date of publication of notice shall be disregarded for the purposes of ascertaining the value of written protests. Written protest may be mailed or hand-delivered in advance of the hearing to LAFCO at 80 S. Lake Avenue, Suite 870, Pasadena, CA 91101 (626) 204-6500. Mailed or hand-delivered protests must be received by 5:00 p.m. on the business day preceding the hearing date to be counted for purposes of valuing protests, or protests may be submitted at the hearing prior to the conclusion of the hearing.
