
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING/PROCEEDINGS

MSR NO. 2019-10 MUNICIPAL SERVICE REVIEW AND SHPERE OF INFLUENCE UPDATE FOR THE WRIGHTWOOD COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

Pursuant to Government Code Section 56150 *et seq.,* the Local Agency Formation Commission for the County of Los Angeles ("LAFCO" or "Commission") hereby gives notice as follows:

- 1. LAFCO will hold a hearing/proceedings on Wednesday, January 8, 2020 at 9:00 a.m., to hear and receive any oral or written protest, objections, or evidence that is made, presented, or filed regarding the proposed Municipal Service Review (MSR) and Sphere of Influence (SOI) Update for the Wrightwood Community Services District ("Proposal"). The hearing will be held in the Board of Supervisors Hearing Room, Room 381B, Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, 500 West Temple Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012, or to such date and time as it may be continued by LAFCO.
- 2. The Hearing/Proceedings include potential action on a Commission-initiated MSR and SOI Update.
- The Proposal has been assigned the following short form designation:
 "MSR No. 2019-10—Municipal Service Review and Sphere of Influence Update for the Wrightwood Community Services District".
- 4. The Proposal includes the proposed adoption of a Municipal Service Review and an Update to the Sphere of Influence for the Wrightwood Community Services District.
- 5. The affected territory is generally located southwest of the intersection of Angeles Crest Highway and Big Pines Highway, in unincorporated San Bernardino County and unincorporated Los Angeles County in the community known as Wrightwood. See map on reverse for a complete description of the exterior boundaries of the proposed MSR and SOI update.
- 6. The reason for the Proposal is that state law requires that LAFCO periodically prepare MSRs for public agencies within LAFCO's jurisdiction (Government Code Section 56430 et seq) and designate and periodically update an SOI for each public agency (Government Code Section 56425 et seq).
- 7. Said hearing/proceedings on the Proposal for MSR and SOI update will be held at 9:00 a.m., on the 08th day of January 2020, in Room 381B of the Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, 500 West Temple Street, Los Angeles, California, 90012, or as it may be continued. At said hearing/proceedings, any interested person may present testimony or submit written opposition or comments prior to the conclusion of the Commission hearing/proceedings on the Proposal. In the event that any written opposition or comments are mailed or hand-delivered to LAFCO, rather than being hand-delivered to the hearing location listed herein before the conclusion of the Commission hearing/proceedings on this Proposal, such mailed or hand-delivered written opposition or comments must be received by the LAFCO Office, at the different address given below, no later than 5:00 p.m. on the business day preceding the date set for hearing/proceedings in order for the mailed or hand-delivered opposition or comments to be deemed timely and to be considered by the Commission in connection with the noticed hearing/proceedings.
- 8. The subject Proposal and all related documents are on file in the office of the Local Agency Formation Commission, 80 South Lake Avenue, Suite 870, Pasadena, California 91101, and may be examined by any person upon request. LAFCO meeting agendas are posted on-line prior to the meetings at www.lalafco.org. For further information, contact the LAFCO office at (626) 204-6500. The office hours are Monday Thursday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., closed Fridays and Holidays.

Depending on the application involved, State Law requires that LAFCO notify various parties, such as landowners and registered voters, both within and adjacent to the affected territory. For this reason, you may receive multiple copies of this notice.
