Award of Contract for Audit Services.

The Executive Officer informed the Commission as of the January 31, 2011 deadline, LAFCO received four proposals.

On motion of Commissioner Yaroslavsky, seconded by Commissioner Pellissier, unanimously carried, the Commission awarded contract for auditing services to Vasquez & Company LLP, at a total cost of \$21,000, to perform an audit of the Commission's financial statements for fiscal years ending June 30, 2008, 2009, 2010 and 2011, with an option to extend for two additional years, upon approval by the commission, and authorized the Executive Officer to finalize negotiations with Vasquez & Company LLP; and execute the contract.

East Los Angeles Incorporation Status Report

The Executive Officer gave a brief overview on the progress of the Comprehensive Fiscal Analysis (CFA).

Commissioner Close stated he would like to see a timeline.

Supervisor Molina voiced concerns with the Commission not having an opportunity to review the Draft CFA prior to the proposed June 22, 2011 hearing date. County Counsel clarified that the Government Code mandates that the EO transmit a staff report and related documents to the Commission at least 5 day prior to any given meeting date. Consequently, the draft CFA will be available to commissioners prior to the scheduled meeting date. She further suggested that perhaps the EO could conduct a workshop, one specifically for commissioners and another in the community to highlight key components of the CFA.

Speaker: Benjamin Cardenas, President of East Los Angeles Resident Association, addressed the commission regarding clarification of what date the data was/will be provided to EPS.

Executive Officer said he will work on producing a timeline and look into options on holding a workshop.
