

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ADOPT A RESOLUTION OF APPLICATION TO INITIATE THE DISSOLUTION OF THE SATIVA COUNTY WATER DISTRICT ("NOTICE OF INTENTION")

Pursuant to Government Code Section 56650 *et seq.*, the Local Agency Formation Commission for the County of Los Angeles ("LAFCO" or "Commission") hereby gives notice as follows:

1. LAFCO will hold a meeting on Wednesday, July 11, 2018 at 9:00 a.m., to hear and receive any oral or written objections, or evidence that is made, presented, or filed regarding the proposed Notice of Intention. The meeting will be held in the Board of Supervisors Hearing Room, Room 381B, Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, 500 West Temple Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012, or to such date and time as it may be continued by LAFCO.
2. The Notice of Intention is to be initiated by the Local Agency Formation Commission for the County of Los Angeles.
3. The Notice of Intention involves approximately 179.80 acres of the Sativa County Water District ("Sativa") consisting of a residential area.
4. The affected territory is generally located in the unincorporated community of Willowbrook and three small non-contiguous areas in the City of Compton. See map on reverse for a complete description of the Notice of Intention (see Exhibit "A").
5. The reasons for the Notice of Intention is to initiate dissolution of the Sativa County Water District including but not limited to significant deficiencies in Sativa's management, financial practices, operations, and infrastructure, as documented in LAFCO's prior Municipal Service Review adopted by the Commission in 2006 and reconfirmed in the Municipal Service Review adopted by the Commission in 2012.
6. Said meeting on the Notice of Intention will be held at 9:00 a.m., on the 11th day of July 2018, in Room 381B of the Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, 500 West Temple Street, Los Angeles, California, 90012, or as it may be continued. At said meeting, any subject agency or interested agency/person may present testimony or submit written opposition or comments prior to the conclusion of the Commission meeting. In the event that any written opposition or comments are mailed or hand-delivered to LAFCO, rather than being hand-delivered to the meeting location listed herein before the conclusion of the Commission meeting, such mailed or hand-delivered written opposition or comments must be received by the LAFCO Office, at the different address given below, no later than 5:00 p.m. on the business day preceding the date set for a meeting in order for the mailed or hand-delivered opposition or comments to be deemed timely and to be considered by the Commission in connection with the meeting.
7. The Notice of Intention and all related documents are on file in the office of the Local Agency Formation Commission, 80 South Lake Avenue, Suite 870, Pasadena, California 91101, and may be examined by any person upon request. LAFCO meeting agendas are posted on-line prior to the meetings at www.lalafco.org. For further information, contact the LAFCO office at (626) 204-6500.
