
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING/PROCEEDINGS

ANNEXATION NO. 2015-09 TO THE CITY OF POMONA AND AMENDMENTS TO THE CITIES OF POMONA, INDUSTRY, WALNUT SPHERES OF INFUENCE

Pursuant to Government Code Section 56650 *et seq.,* the Local Agency Formation Commission for the County of Los Angeles ("LAFCO" or "Commission") hereby gives notice as follows:

- 1. LAFCO will hold a public hearing/proceedings on Wednesday, October 10, 2018 at 9:00 a.m., to hear and receive any oral or written objections, or evidence that is made, presented, or filed regarding the proposed <u>annexation of uninhabited territory to the City of Pomona ("Proposal").</u> The hearing will be held in the Board of Supervisors Hearing Room, Room 381B, Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, 500 West Temple Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012, or to such date and time as it may be continued by LAFCO.
- 2. Proceedings for this annexation were initiated by resolution of application by the City of Pomona.
- The Proposal has been assigned the following short form designation:"Annexation No. 2015-09 to the City of Pomona".
- 4. The Proposal includes annexation of 9.06± acres within an Industrial area into the boundary of the City of Pomona; amendments to the cities of Pomona, Industry, and Walnut Spheres of Influence, detachment from Road District No. 1 and withdraw from County Public Library System.
- 5. The affected territory is generally located south of Valley Blvd approximately 2,500 feet northeast of the intersection of Grand Avenue and Valley Blvd. See map on reverse for a complete description of the exterior boundaries of the proposed change of organization.
- 6. The reason for the annexation as set forth in the proposal to LAFCO is for development of 5 concrete tilt up structures.
- 7. Please be advised that, in the event this proposal for annexation is approved by the Commission, the land within the affected territory is potentially subject to the extension or continuation of any previously authorized charge, fee, assessment, or tax by the City.
- 8. Said hearing/proceedings on the proposal for annexation will be held at 9:00 a.m., on the 10th day of October 2018, in Room 381B of the Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, 500 West Temple Street, Los Angeles, California, 90012, or as it may be continued. At said hearing/proceedings, any interested person may present testimony or submit written opposition or comments prior to the conclusion of the Commission hearing/proceedings on the proposal. In the event that any written opposition or comments are mailed or hand-delivered to LAFCO, rather than being hand-delivered to the hearing location listed herein before the conclusion of the Commission hearing/proceedings on this proposal, such mailed or hand-delivered written opposition or comments must be received by the LAFCO Office, at the different address given below, no later than 5:00 p.m. on the business day preceding the date set for hearing/proceedings in order for the mailed or hand-delivered opposition or comments to be deemed timely and to be considered by the Commission in connection with the noticed hearing/proceedings.
- 9. The subject proposal and all related documents are on file in the office of the Local Agency Formation Commission, 80 South Lake Avenue, Suite 870, Pasadena, California 91101, and may be examined by any person upon request. 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
ANNEXATION NO. 2018-04 TO THE CITY OF SANTA CLARITA (PLUM CANYON, SLYLINE RANCH AND NORTH SAND CANYON)

Pursuant to Government Code Section 56650 *et seq.,* the Local Agency Formation Commission for the County of Los Angeles ("LAFCO" or "Commission") hereby gives notice as follows:

- LAFCO will hold a public hearing/proceedings on Wednesday, October 10, 2018 at 9:00 a.m., to hear and receive any oral or written objections, or evidence that is made, presented, or filed regarding the proposed <u>annexation of inhabited territory to the City of Santa Clarita ("Proposal").</u> The hearing will be held in the Board of Supervisors Hearing Room, Room 381B, Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, 500 West Temple Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012, or to such date and time as it may be continued by LAFCO.
- 2. Proceedings for this annexation were initiated by resolution of application by the City of Santa Clarita.
- 3. The Proposal has been assigned the following short form designation: "Annexation No. 2018-04 to the City of Santa Clarita (Plum Canyon, Skyline Ranch and North Sand Canyon)".
- 4. The Proposal includes annexation of 3,118± acres within a residential, commercial, and open space areas into the boundary of the City of Santa Clarita and the City of Santa Clarita Landscaping and Lighting District; detachment from Road District No. 5; withdraw from County Ligating Maintenance District 1687 and County Public Library System; exclusion form County Lighting District LLA-1, Unincorporated Zone; transfer of drainage improvements and related assessments for Plum Canyon and Skyline Ranch; and conveyance, acceptance and retention of certain parks, open space, storm drains, street, sewer, sewer pump station, and water quality facility interest.
- 5. The affected territory is generally located south of Vasquez Canyon Road between Sand Canyon Road and Golden Valley Road in the unincorporated territory adjacent to the City of Santa Clarita. See map on reverse for a complete description of the exterior boundaries of the proposed change of organization.
- 6. The reason for the annexation as set forth in the proposal to is the landowners within the affected territory approached the City of Santa Clarita for annexation. The property owners cite that the quality of services provided by the City and the desire for local government representation are the reason for the annexation.
