
ANNEXATION NO. 2018-06 TO THE SAN GABRIEL VALLEY MOSQUITO AND VECTOR CONTROL DISTRICT AND AMENDMENT TO THE SAN GABRIEL VALLEY VECTOR CONTROL DISTRICT SPHERE OF INFLUENCE

Pursuant to Government Code §56150 et seq., the Local Agency Formation Commission for the County of Los Angeles ("LAFCO" or "Commission") hereby gives notice as follows:

- 1. LAFCO will hold a public hearing/proceedings on Wednesday, September 8, 2021 at 9:00 a.m., to hear and receive any written protest, objections, or evidence that is made, presented, or filed regarding the proposed annexation of inhabited territory to the San Gabriel Valley Mosquito and Vector Control District and amendment to the San Gabriel Valley Mosquito and Vector Control District Sphere of Influence ("Proposal"). The hearing will be conducted as a virtual meeting with telephone 1-415-655-0001 (Access Code: 145 406 3921) and web access (https://lacountyboardofsupervisors.webex.com/lacountyboardofsupervisors/onstage/g.php?MTID=e87 eb1717eb009acf91d0dabf017a481f), pursuant to the provisions of the Governor's Executive Orders N-25-20 and N-29-20, under the modified laws of the Ralph M. Brown Act for the COVID-19 emergency, as well as the County of Los Angeles "Safer at Home Order for Control of COVID-19". Members of the Commission will attend the meeting via teleconference and participate in the meeting to the same extent as if they were present. There will be no physical access to virtual meetings. Any public comments submitted as described below, will be read during the meeting, at a maximum of three minutes per comment, per item.
- 2. Proceedings for this annexation and amendment were initiated by resolution of application by the San Gabriel Valley Mosquito and Vector Control District. The Proposal consists of an annexation that, in the ordinary course, would require the conduct of protest proceedings; however, the Commission hereby gives notice pursuant to Government Code § 56157 that, unless written opposition to the Proposal is received from landowners and/or registered voters within the affected territory before the conclusion of the aforementioned Commission hearing/proceedings on the Proposal, the Commission intends to waive protest proceedings, as authorized by, and in compliance with, California Government Code § 56663.
- The Proposal has been assigned the following short form designation:
   "Annexation No. 2019-06 to the San Gabriel Valley Mosquito and Vector Control District".
- 4. The Proposal includes annexation of 80± acres within a residential area into the boundary of the San Gabriel Valley Mosquito and Vector Control District and amendment to San Gabriel Valley Mosquito and Vector Control District Sphere of Influence.
- 5. The affected territory is generally located north of the intersection of Mountain Laurel Way and Highwood Court in the City of Azusa. See the accompanying map for a complete description of the exterior boundaries of the proposed change of organization.
- 6. The reason for the annexation as set forth in the Proposal to LAFCO is to provide mosquito and vector control services throughout the affected territory.
- 7. Please be advised that, in the event this Proposal for annexation is approved by the Commission, the land within the affected territory is potentially subject to the extension or continuation of any previously authorized charge, fee, assessment, or tax by the San Gabriel Valley Mosquito and Vector Control District.
- 8. Said hearing/proceedings on the Proposal for annexation and amendment will be held at 9:00 a.m., on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of September 2021, unless cancelled or rescheduled by the Commission or the Commission Chair approves an alternate meeting location. At said hearing/proceedings, any interested person may submit written opposition or comments by email at <a href="mailto:info@lalafco.org">info@lalafco.org</a> prior to the conclusion of said hearing/proceedings or by mail to the LAFCO Office at the address below, no later than 5:00 p.m. on the business day preceding the date set for hearing/proceedings in order to be deemed timely and to be considered by the Commission in connection with the noticed hearing/proceedings. Any written opposition and/or comments will be read during the meeting for a maximum of three minutes per comment, per item.

9. The subject Proposal and all related documents are on file in the office of the Local Agency Formation Commission, 80 South Lake Avenue, Suite 870, Pasadena, California 91101, and may be examined by any person upon request. However, due to the implementation of precautionary measures against the Coronavirus (COVID 19), the office is currently closed.
