MSR NO. 2022-02

MUNICIPAL SERVICE REVIEW (MSR) AND SPHERE OF INFLUENCE (SOI) UPDATE FOR THE ANTELOPE VALLEY RESOURCE CONSERVATION DISTRICT (AVRCD) AND THE RESOURCE CONSERVATION DISTRICT OF THE SANTA MONICA MOUNTAINS (RCDSMM)

Pursuant to Government Code Section 56150 *et seq.,* the Local Agency Formation Commission for the County of Los Angeles ("LAFCO" or "Commission") hereby gives notice as follows:

1. LAFCO will hold a hearing/proceedings on Wednesday, March 9, 2022 at 9:00 a.m., to hear and receive any oral or written protest, objections, or evidence that is made, presented, or filed regarding the proposed Municipal Service Review (MSR) and Sphere of Influence (SOI) Update of inhabited territory for the Antelope Valley Resource Conservation District (AVRCD) and the Resource Conservation District of the Santa Monica Mountains (RCDSMM) ("Proposal"), unless cancelled or rescheduled by the Commission or the Commission Chair approves an alternate meeting location. The hearing will be conducted as a virtual meeting to listen by telephone 1-415-655-0001; Access Code: 2598 919 6870) or to listen via web and provide comment:

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
pursuant to the provisions of Government Code § 54953 relative to virtual meetings, as well as the County of Los Angeles "Best Practices to Prevent COVID-19". Members of the Commission will attend the meeting via teleconference and participate in the meeting to the same extent as if they were present. There will be no physical access to virtual meetings. Any public comments submitted as described below, will be read during the meeting, at a maximum of three (3) minutes per comment, per item


- 2. The Hearing/Proceedings include potential action on a Commission initiated MSR and SOI Update.
- 3. The Proposal has been assigned the following short form designation:

"MSR No. 2022-02—Municipal Service Review and Sphere of Influence Update for the Antelope Valley Resource Conservation District and the Resource Conservation District of the Satna Monica Mountains

- 4. The Proposal includes the proposed adoption of an MSR as well as Reconfirmation(s) and/or Update(s) to the SOIs for the AVRCD and the RCDSMM.
- 5. Upon publication of the agenda for the March 9, 2022 Meeting, the Draft MSR/SOI Update will be available on LAFCO's website under "Current Agenda" on the website home page. LAFCO meeting agendas are posted on-line prior to the meetings at www.lalafco.org.
- 6. The affected territory of the AVRCD includes all of the City of Lancaster, all of the City of Palmdale, and portions of the City of Los Angeles and the City of Santa Clarita; unincorporated territory in the Antelope Valley, a portion of the Santa Clarita Valley, and a small area located in the northeasterly San Fernando Valley; significant territory within the Angeles National Forest and the San Gabriel National Monument; jurisdictional boundary also includes County unincorporated territory in southern Kern County; and County unincorporated territory in northeastern Ventura County.
- 7. The affected territory of the RCDSMM includes the Santa Monica Mountains from Point Mugu to Topanga State Park and includes the Simi Hills; four (4) incorporated cities (Agoura Hills, Calabasas, Hidden Hills, and Westlake Village); several unincorporated communities (primarily Malibu and Topanga) in the County of Los Angeles; unincorporated territory in the County of Ventura County, generally south of the City of Simi Valley and east of the City of Thousand Oaks; three discontiguous areas (Chatsworth Reserve Nature Preserve, Pierce College, and Santa Susana Pass Historic Park), each of which is located within the boundaries of the City of Los Angeles; all County unincorporated territory on Santa Catalina Island (the entire island, excluding the City of Avalon); and Federal and State open space/recreation areas, including the Santa Monica Mountains National Recreation Area and Malibu Creek State Park. See accompanying maps for a graphic depiction of the territory involved in the proposed MSR and SOI Update.

- 8. The reason for the Proposal is that state law requires that LAFCO periodically prepare MSRs for public agencies within LAFCO's jurisdiction (Government Code Section 56430 *et seq.*) and designate and periodically update an SOI for each public agency (Government Code Section 56425 *et seq.*).
- 9. Said hearing/proceedings on the Proposal will be held at 9:00 a.m., on the 9th day of March 2022, unless cancelled or rescheduled by the Commission or the Commission Chair approved an alternate meeting location. At said hearing/proceedings, any interested person may submit written opposition or comments by email at info@lalafco.org prior to the conclusion of said hearing/proceedings or by mail to the LAFCO Office at the address below, no later than 5:00 p.m. on the business day preceding the date set for hearing/proceedings in order to be deemed timely and to be considered by the Commission in connection with the noticed hearing/proceedings. Any written opposition and/or comments will be read during the meeting for a maximum of three (3) minutes per comment, per item.
